Qualification Overview

This qualification reflects the role of educators in early childhood education and care who work in regulated children's education and care services in Australia. They support children's wellbeing, and development in the context of an approved learning framework.

Educators use a range of well-developed skills and knowledge using discretion and judgment when carrying out their work in the context of established policies and procedures. They may work independently or under the guidance of others, though in some contexts that guidance may not be on-site. (Ref: training.gov.au)

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification. However, students must successfully pass a Language, Literacy and Numeracy and digital literacy test prior to their enrolment.
