Pre Requisites:

There are no formal pre requisites to this qualification however students will need to successfully pass a Literacy and Numeracy test upon enrolment and obtain a Working With Children's Check before commencing their placement.

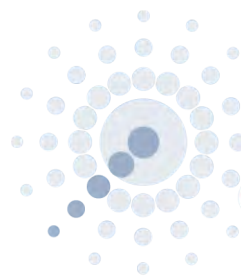
