Qualification Overview

This qualification reflects the role of workers who assist teachers and support student learning in a range of classroom settings under the guidance of a teacher or other educational professional. At this level, workers may be involved in facilitation of learning for a range of instructional groupings, including for those students in need of additional support. In these roles, the education support worker sources and analyses information from diverse sources, may work with limited direct supervision and could provide guidance to other workers. Pre Requisites:

There are no formal pre requisites to this qualification however, students must successfully pass a Language, Literacy and Numeracy test prior to their enrolment and obtain a Working With Children's Check before commencing their placement.

Career Opportunities:

- Learning Support Officer

- Teacher assistant
- Teacher aide

Placements:

Students will participate in 100 hours of work placement in a classroom environment catering to primary or secondary school students. A competent qualified supervisor (Qualified Teacher) will mentor and supervise individual students.

Duration

Average completion time is 8 months. The full qualification must be completed within 24 months from the date of enrolment and regular submission of assessment tasks is required.
