Qualification Overview

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of education settings, including public and independent schools and community education settings, who provide assistance and support to teachers and students under broad-based supervision.

Some job roles may require tasks to be performed with a moderate level of autonomy and/or the provision of supervision/leadership to other staff/volunteers.

Pre Requisites:

There are no formal pre requisites to this qualification however, students must successfully pass a Language, Literacy and Numeracy test prior to their enrolment and obtain a Working With Children's Check before commencing their placement.

Career Opportunities:

Placements:

Students will participate in 100 hours of supervised work in a formal education setting, including public and independent schools. A competent qualified supervisor (Qualified Teacher) will mentor and supervise individual students.

Duration

Average completion time is 8 months. The full qualification must be completed within 24 months from date of enrolment and regular submission of assessment tasks is required.
